Appointments of 30 minutes are available from 10am – 3.15pm

The Coalfields Community Grants Programme in Wales can award grants from £500 up to £7,000.

This programme is for community and voluntary organisations that can demonstrate strongly that a grant will impact positively on people living in the coalfield communities of Wales. Grants will be awarded for projects that can be completed within 12 months and can identify clear positive outcomes for people that can be measured.

Projects will need to meet one or more of the following themes to be eligible for support from the Community Grant Programme Wales:

- Job creation and employment support;
- Social enterprise development;
- Skills and training;
- Community buildings;
- Tackling Poverty;
- Health and wellbeing.
