What is Community Navigation?

Our service will help people in Bridgend County Borough to access community level services, information and advice. It aims to help people maintain or regain their independent lives and prevent their circumstances deteriorating to a point where they might need a higher level of support.

We aim to:

- increase understanding of choices;
- support and empower people;
- improve social and emotional wellbeing;
- promote independence;
- reduce social isolation, loneliness and exclusion.

We are a one-to-one, person centred service for YOU!

Who is the service for?

- Older people (50+);
- People with learning disabilities;
- People living with dementia;
- Carers of any of the above.

We can also work closely with individuals living with mild mental health conditions in the eastern part of Bridgend and with families in contact with our Early Help Hubs.

An introduction can be received from anyone including from the individual themselves.



What can a Navigator do for you?

We can support you to take positive steps to improve your health and wellbeing, improve your social interaction and help you enjoy a more independent life within your community.

> Through having a one-to-one conversation, we can provide information on local services and groups to suit your needs and widen your social network!
