This fund aims to protect and progress community sport clubs and organisations in Wales through the Covid-19 pandemic and into the future. It offers two grants to address different challenges faced by clubs and organisations:

1. Protect grants of £300 - £5,000 for emergency support

*You will need to make a contribution of 10% for grants over £10,000 or 20% over £25,000.
